Public Forum Mr. Lightfoot updated the Board on county matters.

HVFD Report The Board discussed fire contracts and options to become a fire district.

Sewer/Water Mr. McConnell gave the Board a sewer and water report. He is preparing for spring in hopes not to have to haul after the farmers spread. He left at 6:23.

Mayor Lashua gave an update on the water project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the Village of Heuvelton is authorized on behalf of the Village Board of the Village of Heuvelton, to authorize purchase of spare parts for their water system under the Water System Improvements Project at a cost of \$28,973.95, said funds being allocated from remaining project contingency funds.
