

**VILLAGE OF HEUVELTON**  
**Regular Board Meeting**  
**June 11, 2025**

At 6:00 pm, Mayor Lashua called the meeting to order, she opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance. Trustees in attendance were Trustee A. Guardino, Trustee M. Hebert, Trustee E. Wood, and Trustee C. Basford. Also, in attendance were D. Rohe and C. Fout, DANC; and A. Spaman, DPW Supervisor.

**PUBLIC FORUM** The Board discussed items from Joe Lightfoot.

**HVFD** The Board looked forward to future budgets and expenses for the Fire Department, a group will meet to plan for upcoming contracts.

**WATER/SEWER** Mr. Rohe informed the Board that HUNT has conducted the water tower inspection. Hydrant flushing will be performed this month. DANC will coordinate with Mr. Spaman so the backup well will get exercised at that time. Mr. Rohe will get information on an analyzer for the back up well. Mayor Lashua informed the Board that a PFAS settlement offered \$193,236.26, more information to come. Rensselaer street pump quote was reviewed. The Board would like an additional pump fixed and ready on the shelf for a backup.
