Special Board Meeting March 17, 2021 Zoom

At 6:01 pm Mayor Lashua opened the meeting. Trustees in attendance were Tr. Guardino, Tr. Wood, and Tr. Basford. Tr. Knowlton was absent. Also in attendance were K. Feuka, C2AE; C. Tuttle, DANC; D. Merrill, DANC; and T. Haynes, DANC.

Mayor Lashua thanked everyone for coming and began discussion about the Water Tower project. She asked the engineers to address the concerns the Board had with changing the contract. C. Tuttle described the issues with contract three that are addressed with this change order. She offered suggestions on how the Village can still complete the work. K. Feuka added the change can shift priority to focus on improvements to the backup well. They stated it is in the Villages best interest. They will begin a request to extend the project completion for two years.

Wood, Mayor Lashua-Yes Resolution to accept change order 3-3 deleting Rensselaer and Washington Streets work from the contract, decreasing the price by \$223,800.00 making the total contract price for contract three \$1,618,440.00; also accepting time extension for completion.

T. Haynes left at 6:25. Mr. Feuka explained an agreement amendment for C2AE. Soil boring on Rensselaer Street will provide information on how much work completion would require.

Basford, Mayor Lashua-Yes Resolution to accept amendment 5 to the C2AE Water System Improvements Agreement, to perform additional professional services needed for upgrades to back-up well, administering the SEQR review, for an increase of \$9,000; also subcontract soil boring services, for an increase of \$2,000; for an agreement amount total of \$601,000.00.

Mr. Merrill discussed the needed software for the sewer consolidation project.

integration of SCADA equipment and software; at a cost not to exceed \$100,000.00.

C. Tuttle, K. Feuka, and D. Merrill left at 6:38. The Mayor address the Board about her concerns for the Summer Recreation program. New guidance will come out and she will have more information for the next meeting. She also stated the County is updating the disaster mitigation plan and the Village will participate.
