WATER TALK

Water Reminder as cold weather continues, it is important to make sure your waterlines are protected from freezing. Residents with a previous history of frozen pipes should run their water, at a trickle, during subzero temperatures. If your water lines do freeze, please notify the Village Office as soon as possible.

Ice Skating: Weather permitting, ice skating is now available at the pavilion. Skate at your own risk. Open till 10pm. Be respectful of the facilities and other skaters.

SEWER TALK

Sewer The Village has been having trouble with the sewer system getting clogged. Flushing trash leads to service interruptions and expensive repairs to municipal plumbing lines. When a clog or breakdown occurs, untreated sewage could backup into your home and neighborhood. If untreated sewage backs up into the streets, it also has a chance of entering our storm drains and waterways. If these clogs continue occurring in the municipal sewer line, the cost of repairs could be passed on to users (you and your neighbors) in the form of higher utility fees. By being mindful of what you flush down the toilet, you can protect the Village plumbing system and ensure its efficient operation for years to come.

TRASH TALK

Trash and Recycling pickup is every Monday *except* on Holidays. Trash and Recycling must be put out by 7am. If the truck has been by your home and your trash was not out for pick up, please don't call us to come back and pick it up.

Holiday Trash Schedule:

The trash will be picked up on
Tuesday after the holiday.

As winter weather continues, please be mindful of where you set your trash/recycling out so it will not get buried by the snowplow.

To avoid water accumulating in your trash bin, drill some small holes in the bottom of the bin. If your bins are blowing or rolling away when empty, secure some weights inside the bin.

Recycling is required by law. Recycling can be mixed together in one bin, just put your sticker on an item visible on the top.

Please put trash/recycling out weekly. Trash that has been left to accumulate for weeks is a health hazard to Village employees. We reserve the right to refuse pickup.

Black Bags or Untagged trash and recycling will not be picked up!

Trash and recycling stickers can be purchased at Stewart's, Heuvelton Farm Center, and the Village Office.
