Did you know from 1893-1928 Heuvelton gained national fame for being the world's largest dressed turkey market. Village farmers would ship more than 40 tons of turkey for Thanksgiving and 20 to 25 tons for Christmas.

Fall Brush Pickup: will run from October 1st – November 13th DO NOT PUT BRUSH OUT AFTER NOVEMBER 13th

Parking: There is no parking on the Village streets between the hours of 2 am and 6 am from December 1st through March 31st. **There will also be no overnight parking in the Municipal parking lot. Also, please do not park on or block the sidewalks as it interferes with snow removal. This will be enforced.**

Important: When clearing snow from your property please make sure that you do not push the snow onto the sidewalks. This will make snow removal from the sidewalks exceedingly difficult, and the equipment can be damaged.

Snowmobiles: For safety and maintenance, please be reminded that snowmobiles are not permitted on Village sidewalks. Please be respectful of property owners.

Livestock Law- Please be reminded that the Village has a livestock law. If you have or are planning to keep anything considered farm animals, such as horses, cows, pigs, goats, chickens etc., please contact the Village office to get the required applications for a permit.

Village Comprehensive Plan Since April 2024, a committee of Village stakeholders and staff from the County Planning Office regularly met to draft the Village of Heuvelton comprehensive plan. This plan includes a community profile that outlines the Village's history, a demographic profile, a land use overview, and a natural and built feature assessment; community characteristics, goals and recommendations that includes three main sections on outdoor recreation, the Village's business environment, and the community interests/infrastructure. The Village Board intends to adopt this plan in November.

SEWER TALK

Sewer The Village has been having issues with the sewer system getting clogged with items that should not be flushed. Flushing trash leads to service interruptions and expensive repairs to municipal plumbing lines. Please help keep costs down by being conscious of what you are flushing down the toilet.



WATER TALK

Water Reminder with cold weather ahead it is important to make sure your waterlines are protected from freezing. Residents with a previous history of frozen pipes should run their water, at a trickle, during subzero temperatures. If your water lines do freeze, please notify the Village Office as soon as possible.

TRASH TALK

Trash and Recycling pickup is every Monday *except* on Holidays. Trash and Recycling need to be put out by 7am.

The following holidays are coming up:

***Veterans Day Monday 11/11/24**
***Martin Luther King Jr. Day 1/20/25**
These weeks trash will be picked up on Tuesday after the holiday.

With winter weather ahead please be mindful of where you set your trash/recycling out so it will not get buried by the snowplow.

Recycling is required by law. Recycling can be mixed together in one bin, just put your sticker on an item visible on the top. If you mix trash with recyclables they will not be picked up. The Village truck could be denied at the transfer station if we do not abide by requirements.

Please put trash/recycling out weekly. The crew should not have to deal with unpleasant critters. If your trash has been left to accumulate for weeks and is a health hazard to Village employees, we reserve the right to refuse pickup.

Untagged trash and recycling will not be picked up!

Trash and recycling stickers can be purchased at Stewart's, Heuvelton Farm Center, and the Village Office.
